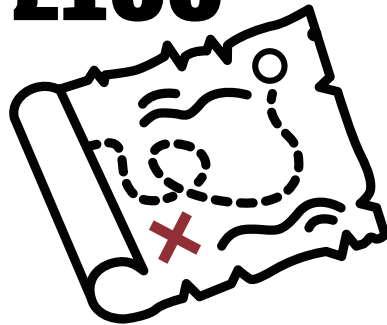

Owned by Craig & Lynne McLaren since 1993, this warm and friendly Freehouse is to the north side of Norwich cathedral. 'The Wig' as its affectionately known, has built a reputation for local ale and Norfolk sourced cuisine. 2018 celebrates 25 years of family ownership and 20 years inclusion in the CAMRA Good Beer Guide. Not bad for a pub that in 1993 was condemned for closure by Grand Metropolitan PLC

The building is Grade II listed and dates to the 16th century. It was known as the White Lion under its first licensee, John Starr, in 1760. In 1985 its name changed to the Wig & Pen, reflecting its proximity to the Magistrates' Courts.
